Passport Requirements for U.S. Citizens

To Enter Canada: U.S. citizens traveling to Canada are required to show U.S. Government-issued photo ID and proof of U.S. citizenship, such as a birth certificate.

To re-enter the United States:

By Air: ALL PERSONS traveling by air outside of the United States are required to present a passport or other valid travel document to enter or re-enter the United States.

By Land or Sea: U.S. citizens need to present either (a) a passport, passport card (available in spring 2008), or [WHTI-compliant document](#); or (b) a government-issued photo ID, such as a driver's license, along with proof of citizenship, such as a birth certificate.

As early as June 1, 2009, the U.S. government will implement the full requirements of the land and sea phase of WHTI. The proposed rules require most U.S. citizens entering the United States at sea or land ports of entry to have a passport, passport card, or [WHTI-compliant document](#).
