Who We Are

Since 1999, the B.C. Mission Boat Society has sent many teams on short-term mission trips to different remote First Nations communities along the B.C. coast. We used to charted a boat until 2010 and are now using ferries and water taxis to travel to the communities.

Teams are immersed into all aspects of the communities they visit. They are supported by a B.C. Mission Boat staff member or experienced volunteer.

Planning a Mission Trip

Team Leader's Task

- We suggest that two people share this role
- Present BCMBS to your congregation
- Assemble the team and submit the team application and team fees,
- Book transportation to Campbell River
- Prepare the team within 6 months of the trip both spiritually and by leading them through the training.
- Help your team find their strengths and giftings in order to have them share God's love in community with humility and confidence.
- Lead fundraising efforts.
- Work through all of the sections of the Leader's Notebook.
- Coordinate post trip follow-up with the team.
- Present to your congregation post trip.

BCMBS Staff Task

- Answer any questions before a decision has been made to come on a mission trip.
- Send the Team Leader Mission
 Trip Notebook and consistently
 coach and have regular meetings
 with team leader.
- Coordinate dates with the mission community.
- Follow up on all necessary team documents.
- Coordinate all water taxis, ferries, and rental vehicles and prepares trip itinerary.
- Coordinate pick up of teams from airports upon arrival to Comox Valley and book either; YFC camp or Bethany Lutheran Church for overnight pre and post trip.
- Provide all inventory and Leader's binder.

Team Member Requirements

- Each team member will be required to submit a clean vulnerable sector criminal record check (every three years) and provide both a personal and pastoral reference check.
- BCMBS staff will provide documentation to each individual member upon receipt of the team application

Team Training

- There are six training modules that each team will work through within the six months prior to arriving for their mission trip.
- These modules are designed to help with team building and preparing teams for their mission trip in various areas.

Team Fee

- Each team is required to pay a
 \$2,000.00 fee to cover incommunity event supplies and
 snacks, administrative costs, pre and
 post trip accommodations and
 training, and team gear
