B.C. Mission Boat Society Ministry Projects for 2026

Dear Friends and Supporters of the B.C. Mission Boat Society,

Thank you for your faithful support of the B.C. Mission Boat Society. Your generosity makes it possible for us to continue sharing Christ's love and serving alongside remote coastal First Nations communities in British Columbia.

As we look ahead, there are several specific areas where financial support would make a meaningful difference. Each of these opportunities helps us strengthen relationships, encourage families, equip our teams, and create spaces where people can hear and experience the love of Christ.

Retreats — \$10,000–\$15,000

We would like to develop opportunities for both women and men in the communities we serve to gather for meaningful times of fellowship, learning, and spiritual encouragement.

A larger retreat would provide opportunities for couples and individuals to participate in small-group and breakout sessions focused on topics community members have identified as important. These may include substance abuse, healthy communication within relationships, continuing conversations around grief and loss, and spiritual support.

We also hope to offer shorter winter retreats in Campbell River, bringing women of different ages together around a Bible study topic while providing an opportunity to learn a practical skill. For example, participants might receive instruction in traditional beading or weaving.

A gift toward retreats helps create safe and welcoming spaces where people can connect with one another, explore important life issues, and be encouraged in their faith.

Kid's Club Supplies — \$500

Kid's Club is an important part of our ministry. Through Bible stories, songs, puppets, crafts, games, and snacks, children are given an opportunity to learn about God's love in a fun and welcoming environment.



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Many of our games and puppets have been well used and are now in need of replacement. We would also like to expand our supplies for the Cariboo Circuit teams preparing to serve in Bella Bella and Bella Coola.

A gift of \$500 would help replenish and expand our Kid's Club supplies, allowing teams to continue providing engaging, Christ-centred activities for the children they serve.

Team Bedding Replacement — \$1,200

Our mission teams spend long days serving in the communities we visit, and a good night's rest is essential.

Our current airbeds and cots are becoming worn and are bulky and heavy to transport. We would like to replace them with lightweight, comfortable folding cots and sleeping pads that are easier to pack and transport while still providing our teams with a good night's rest.

A gift of \$1,200 would allow us to upgrade the bedding used by an average team of six, making travel and accommodations easier for the volunteers who give their time to serve.

Office Laptop Replacement — \$1,000

As a mission, travel—whether local or long distance—is an important part of our work. While our office desktop computer serves us well when we are in the office, there are many times when our work takes us away from our desk.

A reliable laptop is essential for continuing to communicate, coordinate teams, prepare for ministry, and stay connected with the communities we serve while travelling. Unfortunately, our current office laptop is very outdated and is no longer reliable or functional for the work we need it to do.

A gift of \$1,000 would provide a new, reliable laptop that can travel with our staff and allow the work of the mission to continue wherever ministry takes us.
